

Chapter 6

The Lessons of Love

The teachers of God should teach only love. The crucifixion was an extreme example of being treated unjustly by the world. Most people feel persecuted and can become pawns to those who instigate wars, uprisings, and rebellions by encouraging the egos of the masses to project all of their anger upon the "bad guys." Yet, this has not made the world a safer place to live in. This is because the world is permeated by fear, which fosters rejection and makes appreciation impossible.

Teaching rejection is meaningless. When you know who you are, you would never feel fear, anger, or abandonment. The Holy Spirit tries to inspire your perceptions to see only beauty. The full awareness of the Atonement is that the separation never really occurred. The message of the Holy Spirit is that the Kingdom is yours now. Align as one with your brothers to proclaim it. Teach only love, because that is what you are.

The Only Answer

The alternative to projection is the relinquishment of attack in any form. Because your mind is now split, it projects the rejected part upon others with both justification and anger. The Holy Spirit tries to convince you that there is no need for projection but only inclusion. The Holy Spirit attempts to guide the ego's judgmental projections into a perception of friendliness and peace: "You are not rejected but aligned to the light of the world."

You keep learning what you teach, and to be free from conflict you must teach only love. By seeing yourself as a loving being you do not feel attacked. A safe mind is always a benign mind. **You must become aware of what the ego believes and teach just the opposite.** The Holy Spirit is the only answer to everything.

You made the ego without love, and so it does not love you. This automatically isolates you without any **sense** of identity. **The ego does not know anything!** It is merely a fearful mechanism for self-preservation. The ego makes the body its ally and convinces you that the body is more real than the mind. There is only one answer to all of your problems and questions: **You are a child of God, a priceless part of His Kingdom, which He created as part of Him.**

Abilities were introduced as potentials to be developed and are not accomplishments. We love stories in which a person has developed an ability to get himself out of an impossible situation. If you believed in your perfection, you would understand how meaningless special abilities are.

Death does not end the delusions of the ego because, in reality, there is no death of the mind. To the Holy Spirit there is no difficulty in the order of miracles. Only one equal gift can be offered to the equal Sons of God and this is full appreciation.

The body is a means of communication and sharing in a manner of communion. The ego uses it for attack, pleasure, and pride. The Holy Spirit leads you back to God by translating all communications into being and all perception into knowledge. His teachings are: **To have, give all to all. To have peace, teach peace to learn it.**

Everyone identifies himself or herself with their thought system. This means that strengthening one's motivation for change is the most difficult and the final goal of a teacher.
